

The Charta of Free University of Scania (FUS)

The Free University of Scania (FUS) is an entity aiming at creating and distributing scientific knowledge.

FUS consists of the members of the Faculty of FUS.

FUS represents and support the academic virtues of independence, critique, free speech and thought.

The motto of FUS is based on the Enlightenment motto, Sapere aude, i.e., 'Dare to know'. We add 'Dare to tell'. The motto of FUS is 'Sapere aude, dicere aude', ***'Dare to know, dare to tell'***.

Members of FUS are those that have been included or excluded for membership by the members. Suggestion for inclusion and exclusion of a member can be made by a member and will be determined through a voting where every member have to give an open vote of yes, no or abstain, where a decision is made if the suggestion gets more than 66% yes of the votes.

A member accepts the Charta of FUS and represents the virtues of FUS.

The Charta of FUS can be changed after a suggestion from one or several members, followed by three voting occasions, with one year between each voting, and with more than 66% yes of the votes each time.
