

## **Hypocrisy and revenge makes the world go around**

The Earth is the sacred place of hypocrisy and revenge. Justice, in the meaning of equal treatment is for fools and stupid people. This is the story behind this conclusion.

Today (16 of July), we read that Laszlo Csatory is probably found in Budapest. He was a mean, savage brutal policeman in the former Hungarian town Kassa and was responsible for the deportation of more than 15 000 Jews. After the war he was wanted for war crimes and sentenced to death in absentia in Czechoslovakia 1948, but has been able to hide until today. He is now 97 years of age.

The Simon Wiesenthal Center, an organization devoted to teach the lessons of the Holocaust, has paid 25 000 dollars to the tipper. Dr Efraim Zuroff, director of the Simon Wiesenthal Centre, claims that "...time should never diminish the crimes committed in the Holocaust — or excuse those responsible from facing punishment."(The Sun, 16 July 2012)

Let us compare. Menachem Begin, well-known terrorist, leader of Irgun, a terror organisation, at least according to the British government, responsible for the bombing of a hotel in Jerusalem that killed 91 persons, responsible of the settlement occupation of Sinai, got Nobel price of Peace, and was respected leader of Israel at the end of the 70'ies. According to my knowledge he was never put to trail and had to face punishment for his crime against humanity. On the contrary, he was a respected leader of a nation.

Yitzhak Shamir, well-known terrorist, organised in Lehi, also called the Stern Gang, was responsible for the killing of Folke Bernadotte 1948, but also respected leader of Israel during the 80'ies. According to my knowledge he was never put to trail and had to face punishment for his crime against humanity. On the contrary, he was a respected leader of a nation.

What is the difference between the killer Csatory and the killers Begin and Shamir? Why is it important to teach the future about the Holocaust through chasing Csatory and why was it not important to teach about the horror of terrorism through chasing Begin and Shamir? There is no difference, except if you accept the principle of hypocrisy and the principle that justice is made by the winners.

And concerning Csatory, which reasonable person believes, except the victims of him, which is understandably but an act of revenge, that Holocaust will be remembered as long as we find the criminals and put them to jail? The massacres of Rwanda and Srebrenica are a powerful and horrible falsification of that belief.

The only justice I can find here is the justice of politics and of revenge. The teaching here is about the gains of hypocrisy and justice by power distribution. My conclusion is this: Principles of justice are buried in Königsberg. Principles of humanity are buried at Golgotha.

The only thing we can do is to ask us, what act of love can I do today, here and now, that could be repeated by all my fellowmen, without distinction? Then we will slowly rub off the brutality of hypocrisy and revenge.
